Instructions

1. Apply for degree granting program, if needed. The Admissions Office would be your starting point.
2. Register for courses. (Up to 9 credits can be waived each semester. Students are responsible for any fees and tuition cost exceeding 9 credits at the standard tuition rate.)
3. Ensure you have completed all in-state tuition residency requirements.
4. Complete a Senior Citizen Request for Tuition Waiver for each semester that you qualify for the program. Submit completed request to the Human Resources Office.
 - a. Once the form is processed in Human Resources, it will be sent to Accounts Receivable for further review and processing.
5. Pay balance due online or at the Cashiers Office by the due date.
6. Once the request is processed, the benefit will be reflected in GullNet.
