Professional Program Admission Requirements

- A GPA of <u>2.5 or higher</u> in the pre-professional core courses is required for admission into the Professional Program, including those courses taken at another institution.
- Grades of <u>C or higher</u> must be earned in all pre-professional courses for the following major: <u>Business Economics</u>.
- Complete at least <u>9 out of 11</u> Pre-Professional Courses (26 credits), 5 of which must be <u>MATH</u> <u>155, MATH 160, ECON 211 or ECON 212, ACCT 201, and BUAD 200</u>. The remaining 2 courses must be completed in the first semester after being admitted to the Professional Program.
- Students may repeat each business course **one time only**. If students exceed repeats, they will not be admissible to the Professional Program.
- Students must have completed **40 total credit hours** of college courses to be admitted into the Professional Program.
