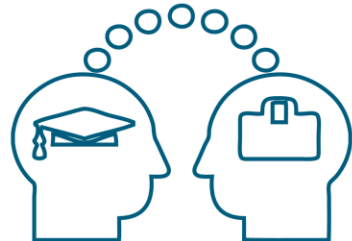

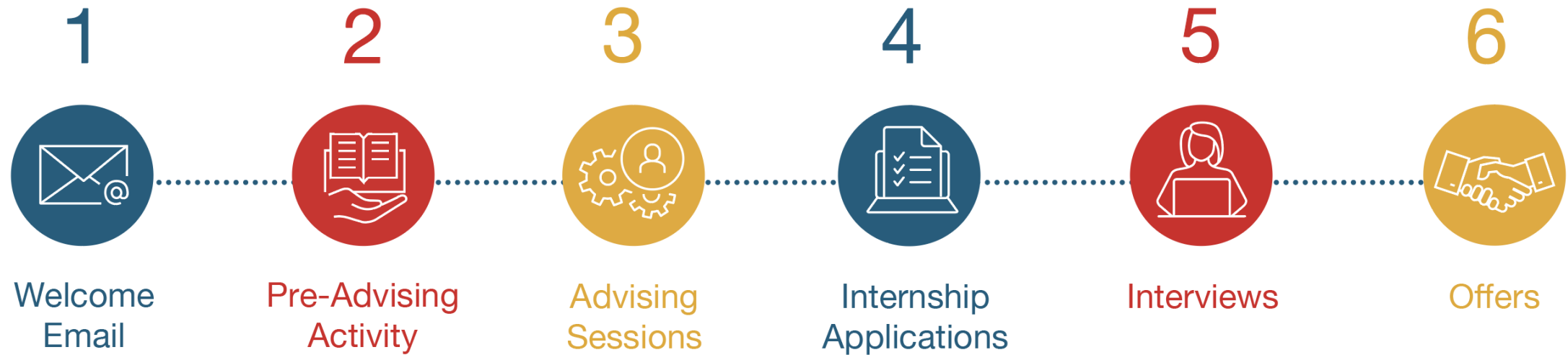

## Cost Arrangements: Tuition | Program | Housing

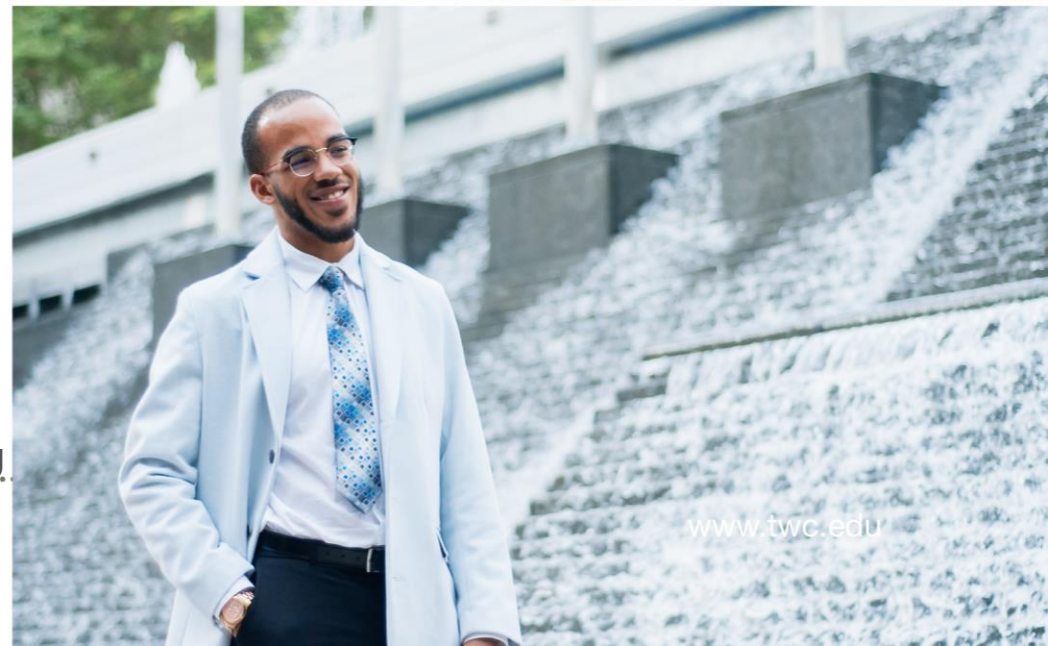
Spring/Fall Cost: SU Tuition + \$9,415 + \$6,570
