



SU Study Abroad Scholarship Application

Award winners are determined by a combination of GPA, application essay, and demonstrated financial need. Winners will receive a scholarship of \$250-\$400 which is applied to any study abroad program **approved** by the SU Center for International Education. Applications are due to the Center for International Education (1015 Camden Avenue) by **3pm Monday, October 16, 2017.**

All applicants must:

- Be a full time SU student with a declared major
- Carry an overall GPA of **3.0 or above**
- Have already applied and been accepted to a program
- Have a current Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) on record at the SU Office of Financial Aid. **A student who does not have a FAFSA on file may attach an additional statement explaining their financial need in the absence of the FAFSA.**
- Submit an Unofficial Transcript demonstrating Cumulative GPA with the application
