Salisbury University is a qualifying employer for the PSLF Program. Faculty (full-time and adjunct), administrators, and staff members may be eligible to have their entire remaining balance of federal student loans eliminated through PSLF--and those who have had loans for more than ten years might benefit more quickly than others.
