

Opportunities

- Gain experience serving with a non-profit or government agency that translates directly into relevant job experience
- Develop effective skills in project management, leadership, and teamwork
- Participate in a lively learning community of fellow AmeriCorps members
- Join a national service movement of over 80,000 members nationwide
- Realize the satisfaction of incorporating service into your life and making a difference in your community and your country

Requirements

- Applicants must have a strong interest in serving the community, be at least 18 years of age, and have reliable transportation.
- Full & Half-time applicants must be available to attend the free, AmeriCorps hybrid class at SU alternate Thursdays, 9:30 a.m. to 10:45 p.m., during the Fall and Spring semesters.
- Must provide documentation of "citizen, national, or permanent resident alien of the United States."
- Applicants will undergo a free Criminal History Check, which includes FBI fingerprinting.
- You DO NOT need to be a student at Salisbury University. Anyone can participate.



What do AmeriCorps Members Do?

Members serve with a nonprofit or government agency partner site for the duration of the commitment. Members often serve in such areas as environmental education, youth development, older adult care, or financial literacy. Previous partner sites have included the City of Salisbury, Health Departments, Libraries and many more! We have a service experience fit for everyone!

Levels of Service & Benefits

Full-time

1700 hours of service (appx. 40 hours/week)

Enrolls Aug.- Oct.

Bi-weekly, pre-tax stipend of \$1,062

- Education award of \$7,395 to help pay for federal student loans and/or future education expenses
- Federal student loan forbearance during service
- Exemption from paying federal student loan accrued interest
- Health insurance & child care reimbursement, if eligible
- Free fall and spring semester training course at SU worth 8 credits

Half-time

900 hours of service (appx. 20 hours/week):

Enrolls Aug.- Oct.

Bi-weekly, pre-tax stipend of \$562

- Education award of \$3,697 to help pay for federal student loans and/or future education expenses
- Federal student loan forbearance during service
- Exemption from paying federal student loan accrued interest payments
- Free fall and spring semester training course at SU worth 8 credits

Minimum-time

300 hours of service (flexible enrollment and completion dates)

- Education award of \$1,565 to help pay for federal student loans and/or future education expenses
- Federal student loan forbearance during service
- Exemption from paying federal student loan accrued interest payments
