The Long Range Academic Planning Committee (LRAP) is charged with completing the following tasks and reporting back to the Faculty Senate on each of them no later than April 2025, with the reports being submitted to the Faculty Senate President a week prior to the meeting. - LRAP will develop suggestions for how the University should plan academic offerings in light of the Blueprint for Maryland’s Future. This should include suggestions related to the development, delivery, and tracking of dual enrollment courses; as well as how the University should address in-state and out-of-state student transfers.
- LRAP will engage with the Strategic Planning process related to expected University enrollment data and targets, including expected impact of the Blueprint on the same.
