Recommendations for Faculty Senate Review

From: The Curriculum Approval Guide (CAG) Review Workgroup

Upon review of the existing CAG, the workgroup collaborated to create a revised version of the CAG with updated content for Faculty Senate (FS) review in response to the charge issued to the Undergraduate Curriculum Committee (UCC) during the 2023-24 FS session.

The following items are outstanding and require FS review, verification, amplification and/or clarification:

- UCC Position Statement (Approved 2000; Revised w/ insertion 2024) There is no clarity about who approves this statement or whether it is appropriate to be placed in the CAG.
 <u>Recommendation</u>: FS to review and revise as needed and have updated version on the UCC webpage with links within the CAG and on FS webpage. <u>Rationale: Position Statements provide transparency and guidance for faculty regarding the scope and responsibilities of the UCC.</u>
- Statement on the Role of the FS in curriculum approval by UCC or Graduate Curriculum
 Committee (GCC) indicated "the right to review all decisions" without context or details.
 Recommendation: FS to act as the adjudicating body for UCC/GCC decisions that are contested
 by faculty originators or schools/ departments prior to review by the Provost. Rationale: The
 current statement is vague and non- instructive. Providing specifics about the circumstances for
 FS involvement in UCC/GCC decisions as well as clarifying lines of authority will be helpful.
- No published timeline or criterion for review of CAG, Position Statements, Standing Rules or Committee Functions/ responsibilities. <u>Recommendation</u>: FS determine a schedule and alteration criterion for review of governing documents for curriculum. <u>Rationale: Faculty</u> <u>guidance documents should be current and relevant to the environment that faculty will be</u> <u>utilizing them in. Creating a schedule allows for automation of the review process.</u>
