This motion seeks to update ex officio title(s) within the Faculty Senate bylaws for the 1) General Education Oversight Committee (GEOC) and 2) Faculty Development Committee.

GEOC Structure

Language will change:

From: The committee shall have seven voting members: one Faculty member elected by and from each Unit and one Faculty member elected at-large. Ex officio members: the Provost; the Registrar; the General Education Program Director, and the Director of University Analysis, Reporting, and Assessment.

To: The committee shall have seven voting members: one Faculty member elected by and from each Unit and one Faculty member elected at-large. Ex officio members: the Provost; the Registrar; the General Education Program Director, and **Associate Vice President for Planning & Assessment**.

Further, these changes shall also be updated and reflected in the GEOC Standing Rules.

Faculty Development Committee

Language will change:

From: The committee shall have six voting members: one Faculty member elected by and from each Unit except the Library, and one elected at-large. Ex officio members: the Manager of Instructional Design and Delivery, and the Assistant Provost for Faculty Success.

To: The committee shall have six voting members: one Faculty member elected by and from each Unit except the Library, and one elected at-large. Ex officio members: the Manager of Instructional Design and Delivery, and **the Director for the Center for the Advancement of Faculty Excellence (CAFE)**.

JUSTIFICATION: Aligns the GEOC Standing Rules and the Faculty Senate Bylaws, ensuring consistency in committee structure language and promoting clarity regarding ex officio representation. Also updates title of ex officio position within the Faculty Senate Bylaws for the Faculty Development Committee.

Positive: The motion improves clarity regarding ex officio roles and reflects the most current organizational structure and titles.
