- I. Reports
  - a. Marvin Pyles
    - i. Volunteer Day announced at President Wight's inauguration. Expect the Volunteer Day to come back to Staff Senate to figure out process/procedure.
    - ii. Meal Plan Approved at \$9/meal or \$225/year
    - iii. Staff Senate continues to have a great track record of proposals and approvals.
    - iv. MCEA negotiations continue.
      - 1. Union wants to meet one more time so they can make recommendations to the budget process.
      - 2. SS workhour proposal is still pending until after MCEA negotiations are concluded.
    - v. SU is now down to approximately 20 unfilled positions.
    - vi. Overall budgets were increased 2 ½ percent.
    - vii. COLA of 3% will be effective at the beginning of FY20 on July 1, 2019 full year.
    - viii. Minimum Wage increase has passed and will be phased in.
    - ix. Equity adjustments for those that were not in the original group.
      - 1. Will review again in February 2020
        - a. The beginning of the spring semester provides a more accurate snapshot of the budget with respect to enrollment.
        - b. The Legislative Session is in full swing.
      - 2. If conditions are favorable, the plan is to proceed with equity adjustments.
    - x. Employee Appreciation concerns were discussed about the date of May 24.
      - 1. Day after Commencement
      - 2. Grades due
      - 3. Day before a long holiday weekend
      - 4. Look into alternate dates
        - a. Move to outside
        - b. Dates other than a Friday
      - 5. Consider using catering vendor (Stefanie will contact Black Diamond)
      - 6. As the event is attended by both faculty and staff, question regarding asking Faculty Senate to contribute to the cost.
      - 7. Teri will send emails to Exec Staff and Deans to ask for gifts.
