
LIMITLESS OPPORTUNITIES

College of Health and Human Services

- SU's School of Nursing is widely regarded as one of the best in the region and our graduates have the highest pass rates in the University System of Maryland on the national nursing certification exams (NCLEX).
- SU offers the only accredited exercise science program in Maryland, featuring built-in internships.
- The School of Social Work offers B.S.W. and M.S.W. programs across the state and in Europe.
- SU's Medical Simulation Center is set up like a real medical facility and features realistic experiences using life-like patient simulators and actors, providing a "safe space" for future health care professionals to practice, make mistakes and master new skills.

Fulton School of Liberal Arts

- The school features an innovative four-credit curriculum, which provides academic and experiential "enhancements" to courses in the humanities, social sciences and fine arts.
- SU is one of only two schools nationally to offer both an undergraduate and graduate degree in conflict analysis and dispute resolution and has the only approved "hot glass" art concentration within the state.
- Named one of The Princeton Review's "Great Schools for Communication Majors," SU has an 18,500 square foot Integrated Media Center for media and music production.
- The school's newest department in environmental studies has produced multiple Environmental Protection Agency Fellowship winners.

Henson School of Science and Technology

- The National Science Foundation has designated SU a special Research Experiences for Undergraduates (REU) site and awarded nearly \$1 million to expand our programs in STEM (science, technology, engineering and math).
- Our dual-degree programs allow students to earn SU degrees in biology, chemistry or physics, then immediately earn a second degree in environmental science, engineering or pharmacy from a partner school.
- Through SU's GIS Cooperative, students work on projects solving real-world issues, spanning Maryland legislative districts to climate change adaptation.
- Located near the Chesapeake Bay and Atlantic Ocean, SU gives students access to research both these unique environments. Also, our close proximity allows for collaborations with NASA's Wallops Island Flight Facility.

Honors College

- The Honors application should be completed when applying to SU. First-year students are encouraged to have a high school GPA of 3.5 or an SAT score above 1200 (or ACT score of 27). Learn more and apply online: www.salisbury.edu/honors
- Honors spans all majors with three options: an interdisciplinary program emphasizing the humanities and enhanced learning experiences; a business program, providing greater networking and entrepreneurial opportunities; and a science and mathematics program, emphasizing critical thinking and targeted research.
- There are two \$1,000-\$2,000 scholarships for freshmen: Bellavance Scholars are based on academics and essay; Director's Fellows have an additional essay and a focus on leadership.
- Completing a required Honors capstone (or thesis) project shows determination and self-motivation, which is attractive to recruiters and graduate schools, giving you a competitive edge.

Perdue School of Business

- Perdue Hall, home of the Eastern Shore's premier center for entrepreneurship, features some \$3.1 million in new technology and is LEED gold certified.
- The annual Perdue Entrepreneurship Competition has a prize pool of some \$100,000 in start-up capital for students with the best new business proposals.
- The Perdue School has twice served as one of the national host locations for ABC's *Shark Tank*.
- It is among only 5 percent of business schools worldwide to be AACSB accredited, and its American Marketing Association chapter has been named one of the top 20 in the country.

Seidel School of Education

- Full accreditation by the National Council for Accreditation of Teacher Education and the Maryland State Department of Education ensures programs meet the highest standards.
- SU has produced nearly 100 Maryland Teachers of the Year since 1996, including two statewide winners.
- SU's collaboration with local school systems has earned multiple national honors, including three Exemplary Professional Development Schools Achievement Awards.
- Secondary education certification can be obtained in biology, chemistry, earth science, English, history, mathematics and physics. Pre-K-12 certification can be obtained in ESOL, physical education, French, Spanish and music.

HANDS-ON LEARNING & RESEARCH FOR ALL MAJORS

Integral to all majors and programs at SU is a focus on hands-on learning and research:

- Office of Undergraduate Research and Creative Activity:
 - Mentor Match - a searchable database to connect faculty researchers with interested student collaborators
 - Undergraduate Research Fellows - student ambassadors who promote research opportunities for students
 - SU Student Research Conference - for over 20 years, this annual conference highlights student accomplishments
- Nationally Competitive Fellowships Office: Work with faculty mentors to compete for prestigious fellowships and awards, including Fulbrights and the Gates Cambridge, so you can conduct research or teach internationally
- SU's Career Services: This hub for connections and career advice hosts internship fairs and maintains a database where you can match your interests with real-world opportunities
