



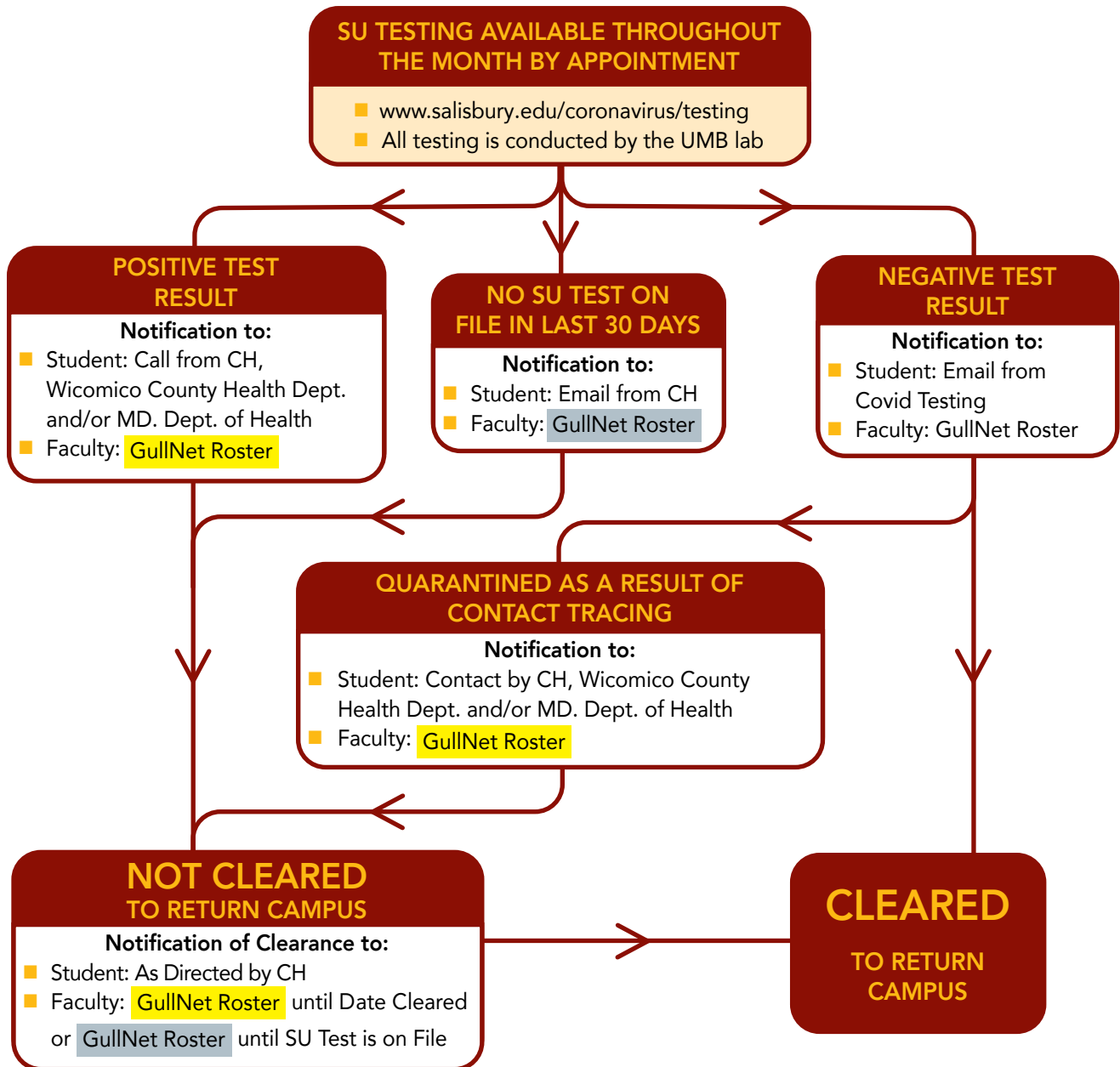
COVID-19

STUDENT MONTHLY TESTING

For SU students who need access to campus for classes, work, study, dining, housing, etc.

Starting March 1, 2021, students will need to be tested weekly to maintain access. Students who test positive for COVID-19 via the rapid test will be exempt from testing during their isolation or quarantine period, but must show up for their next regularly scheduled testing day and time after being cleared to leave isolation or quarantine and receive a negative result to retain building access.

Students who test positive or are quarantined may consult the Process for Requesting Course Modifications after Open Enrollment.
