Unmentionable

Be grateful for modern plumbing, such as you enjoy in this restroom. It is way more efficient and comfortable than the supposed first flush toilet in Salisbury, which included the flushing mechanism to the right. You can learn more about it and the potty training chair below (used in a Nanticoke Road farmhouse in Salisbury in the 1890s) in our current exhibit in the fourth-floor Thompson Gallery in the GAC. Indiscreet Stories of Artifacts”

includes all sorts of “unusual, scandalous, disturbing, awful, discriminatory, uncomfortable, and surprising artifacts” from the Nabb Center’s collection. Among the items on display are objects reflecting some very current topics—racism, sexism, and hair-raising types of medicine and medical practice—as well as some topics that have long made people uncomfortable, such as women’s undergarments, death and mourning, or military-related objects. The exhibit should make you think about what are today’s unmentionables.



Please be aware that there may very well be some objects in the exhibit that you find deeply disturbing. The exhibit will be on display through June 5.
